Barefoot Bowls:

Activities & Event Details:

Newcastle Art Gallery:

Visit the Newcastle Art Gallery and explore the current exhibitions. Opportunity for the participants to take photos of the art to potentially try to recreate when they get home. Please note the Gallery is opened 10am - 5pm, Tuesday to Sunday.

Walk the Fernleigh Track:

Walk along the Fernleigh track.
